Juno Beach Police To Get New Automated External Defibrillators

Juno Beach, FL (June 6, 2018) – The Juno Beach Police Foundation announced today that they have funded the purchase of 10 new Automated External Defibrillators for police department patrol vehicles

Juno Beach police officers often arrive on the scene of medical emergencies before fire-rescue personnel so it is important that they have the equipment necessary to help save lives.

Automated External Defibrillator (AEDs) are portable electronic devices that automatically diagnose life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias and are able to treat them through the application of electricity which stops the arrhythmia, allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm.

Police foundation president Tom Murphy said “Each Juno Beach Police vehicle will now be equipped the latest technology. Combined with the basic life support (BLS) level cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training that each officer receives, it is likely that many lives can be saved.”

The Foundation’s grant is the first following the organizations formation in late March.
